LUMIERE D'ESPOIR (FR), won 2 races (10f. - 14f.) at 3 years, 2001 and £7,353 viz Levy Board Saffie Joseph Handicap, Bath, Joe Sime Memorial Handicap, Doncaster and placed once.

LIGHT OF HOPE (USA), won 2 races at 3 years and £4,369 and placed twice, her only season to race; Own sister to ALZAO (USA);

dam of six winners from 7 runners and 9 foals of racing age-

Happy Heart (FR) (1995 f. by Exit To Nowhere (USA)), won 2 races at 3 and 4 years in France and £50,581 and placed 13 times including third in G.P. Conseil General des Alpes Maritimes, Cagnes-sur-Mer, L. and G. P. Anjou Bretagne-Prix Rose de Loire, Lion d'Angers, L.

Maria de La Luz (GB) (1996 f. by Machiavellian (USA)), won 2 races at 3 and 4 years, 2000 in France and in U.S.A. and £34,816, placed second in La Coupe des Pouliches de Marseille, Salon-Provence, L.

PAS DE COURSE (USA), winner in U.S.A.; dam of REAL SUCCESS (AUS), won Highview Stud Dulcie Stakes, Te Rapa, Gr.2.

POCAHONTAS II, won 3 races in U.S.A. including Schuylerville Stakes, Saratoga;

dam of five winners from 6 runners and 9 foals of racing age including-

TOM ROLFE, Champion 3yr old colt in U.S.A. in 1965, won 16 races in U.S.A. including American Derby, Arlington, Preakness Stakes, Pimlico; a leading sire.
