CEZANNE (GB), Champion older horse in Ireland in 1994, won 10 races at home, in U.A.E. and in Germany including Guinness Champion Stakes, Leopardstown, **Gr.1** and Spreiti-Rennen, Baden-Baden, **Gr.3**, placed second in Rose of Lancaster Stakes, Haydock Park, **Gr.3**; also won 1 race over hurdles; sire.
