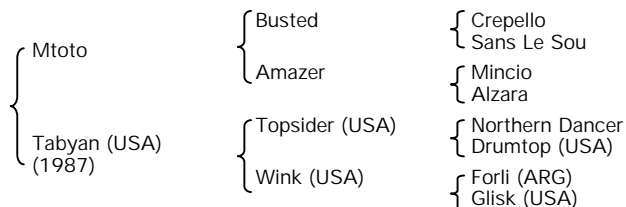

TABYAN (USA), won 1 race at 3 years and £4,292 and placed 3 times; dam of **one winner** from 4 runners and 7 foals of racing age-

CAP JULUCA (IRE) (1992 g. by Mtoto), won 7 races at 3 and 5 years and £125,948 including Gala Stakes, Epsom, **L.**, placed twice including third in Vodafone Diomed Stakes, Epsom, **Gr.3**, from only 11 starts, died at 6 years.

MISRAAH (IRE), 3 races at 2 to 4 years, 2001 including Porcelanosa Sprint Stakes, Sandown Park, **L.**, placed second in Bet with Betabet Achilles Stakes, Kempton Park, **L.** and third in Darley July Cup, Newmarket, **Gr.1**.
