

CUNNING (GB), **won** 4 races, £89,020 including Princess Royal Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.3** and Galtres Stakes, York, **L.** and placed once viz second in Prix Vermeille Escada, Longchamp, **Gr.1**;

dam of two winners from 3 runners and 5 foals of racing age-

EJTITHAAB (IRE) (1997 g. by Arazi (USA)), placed 3 times at 3 years; also won 3 races at 4 and 5 years, 2002 in U.A.E., £22,263.

ALMAYDAN (GB) (1998 g. by Marju (IRE)), won 2 races at 4 years, 2002 and £12,658 and placed 5 times, from only 8 starts.

Samira (GB) (f. by Rainbow Quest (USA)), won 1 race at 3 years and £10,316, placed 7 times including second in Diamond Vision Stakes, Curragh, L.

MUSHRAAF (GB), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £14,015 and placed 3 times. VISION (IRE), won 2 races at 4 years, 2002 in Germany and placed 3 times.

TIGRE (GB), won 1 race at 3 years and £12,058 and placed 8 times; also won 1 race at 4 years, 2001 in Switzerland, £4,000.

COMMANCHÉ CREEK (GB), placed twice at 3 and 4 years; also won 5 races and £16,009 over hurdles and won 3 steeplechases, £11,651 and placed 14 times.
