PINK CRISTAL (GB) (f. by Dilum (USA)), won 2 races at 3 years and £22,053 including Bovis Homes Valiant Stakes, Ascot, L.; dam of a winner.

CRYSTAL SPRAY, won 1 race at 4 years and placed 5 times; dam of winners.

CRYSTAL MUSIC (USA), 3 races at 2 years and £235,571 including Fillies' Mile Stakes, Ascot, Gr.1, second in Coronation Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.1 and Irish 1000 Guineas, Curragh, Gr.1, from only 7 starts.

SOLAR CRYSTAL (IRE), 2 races and £53,595 including May Hill Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.3, third in Prix Marcel Boussac-Criterium des Pouliches, Longchamp, Gr.1; dam of CRYSTAL (IRE), 1 race at 3 years, 2004.

STATE CRYSTAL (IRE), 2 races and £76,856 including Lancashire Oaks, Haydock Park, Gr.3, third in Yorkshire Oaks, Gr.1 and Prix Vermeille, Longchamp, Gr.1; dam of Crystal Curling (IRE), 1 race at 2 years, 2003 and £14,394, placed third in Cheshire Oaks, Chester, L.

DUBAI SUCCESS (GB), 2 races at 3 and 4 years, 2004 and £79,409 viz Dubai Irish Village John Porter Stakes, Newbury, Gr.3, placed 5 times including second in Stan James Geoffrey Freer Stakes, Newbury, Gr.2.

Tchaikovsky (IRE), 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £83,127, second in Derrinstown Stud Derby Trial Stakes, Leopardstown, Gr.3 and third in Irish Derby, Curragh, Gr.1; also placed 5 times in France and in Saudi Arabia.

CRYSTAL PALACE, won 5 races at 2 and 3 years including Nassau Stakes, Goodwood and Falmouth Stakes, Newmarket, placed 3 times viz second in New Ham Foal Stakes, Goodwood, third in Queen Elizabeth II Stakes, Ascot and fourth in Cheveley Park Stakes, Newmarket, from only 9 starts;

ROYAL PALACE, Champion 3-y-o in England in 1967, won 9 races at 2 to 4 years viz Derby Stakes, Epsom, 2000 Guineas, Newmarket, Coronation Cup, Epsom, Eclipse Stakes, Sandown Park, King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes, Ascot, Prince of Wales's Stakes, Royal Ascot; a leading sire.

SELHURST, won 4 races including Hardwicke Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.2; sire.

Ash Lawn, won 1 race, second in Cherry Hinton Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.2; grandam of BROKEN HEARTED, won Lockinge Stakes, Gr.2, Prix Guillaume d'Ornano, Gr.2; sire; third dam of MY BRANCH (GB), won Firth of Clyde S., Ayr, L., third in Irish 1000 Guineas, Gr.1; fourth dam of TANTE ROSE (IRE), 5 races at 2 to 4 years, 2004 including Sprint Cup, Haydock Park, Gr.1.
