Hamaya (USA), ran once at 3 years; dam of winners.
WAQUAAS (GB), 16 races in Norway and in Sweden including Taby Open Sprint Championship, Taby, Gr.3, placed 33 times.
Evening Primrose (USA), unraced; dam of winners.
