RUDIMENTARY (USA), won Forte Mile, Sandown Park, Gr.2 and second in Premio Vittorio di Capua, Milan, Gr.1; sire.

KEEN, 2 races at 2 and 3 years including Easter Stakes, Kempton, L., placed second in St James's Palace Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.2; sire.
