ALFRIDINI (GB): won 3 races (8f. - 10f.) at 3 and 5 years, 2006 and £15,382 viz AW Handicap (Class 5), Lingfield Park, AW Handicap (Category D4), Lingfield Park and Handicap (Category E5), Salisbury, placed 6 times, own brother to REVE DE PAIX (GB) and ALFINI (GB).

Vivre En Paix, won 1 race at 3 years in France and 126,664 fr. and placed 4 times including third in Prix des Lilas, Chantilly, L.;

dam of six winners from 9 runners and 13 foals of racing age viz-
