GHOST DANCER (GB): won 2 races (7f. – 8f.) at 2 and 4 years, 2008 and £15,522 viz Wolf Nursery Handicap Stakes (Class 2), Wolverhampton, Handicap (Class 5), Leicester and placed 4 times viz second in Maiden (Class 5), Ripon, AW Handicap (Class 5), Lingfield Park, third in Handicap (Class 5), Warwick and fourth in AW Maiden (Class 4), Wolverhampton.

RESERVATION (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years and placed once; dam of two winners from 4 runners and 4 living foals of racing age viz- *MARRONNIER* (IRE) (2003 g. by Vettori (IRE)), placed once at 2 years; also won 1 race over hurdles and £6005 and placed 3 times. *GHOST DANCER* (GB) (2004 c. by Danehill Dancer (IRE)), see above. Bingson (IRE) (HK) (2001 c. by Desert Style (IRE)), placed 4 times at 3 years in Hong Kong and £17,626. Expensive Dinner (GB) (2006 f. by Dr Fong (USA)), ran once at 2 years, 2008. She also has a 2007 colt by Bahamian Bounty (GB).
