PEINTURE RARE (IRE) (f. by Sadler's Wells (USA)), won 2 races at 3 and 4 years, 2010 in France and £139,069 including Prix de Pomone, Deauville, **Gr.2**, placed 4 times including second in Qatar Prix de Royallieu, Longchamp, **Gr.2**.

POINTILLISTE (USA) (c. by Giant's Causeway (USA)), won 5 races at 3, 5 and 6 years in France and £186,653 including Prix de Barbeville, Longchamp, **Gr.3**, Prix Rene Bedel, Lyon-Parilly, **L.** and Prix Right Royal, Maisons-Laffitte, **L.**, placed 11 times including second in Prix Vicomtesse Vigier, Longchamp, **Gr.2**.
