MADEIRA MIST (IRE) (f. by Grand Lodge (USA)), 8 races at 3 to 5 years in U.S.A. and £308,740 including Dance Smartly Handicap, Woodbine, **Gr.3**, placed second in Athena Handicap, Aqueduct, **Gr.3**; dam of **JOSHUA TREE (IRE)**, 4 races at 2 to 4 years, 2011 at home, in Canada and in Qatar and £916,966 including Pattison Canadian International Stakes, Woodbine, **Gr.1**.

MISTY HEIGHTS (GB) (f. by Fasliyev (USA)), 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £80,562 including ISF Victor McCalmont EBF Stakes, Gowran Park, **L.**; dam of **Greyfriarschorista (GB)**, 3 races at 3 years, 2010 and £37,167 and placed second in Sportingbet Supports Heros Spring Cup, Lingfield Park, **L.**
