GREY GODDESS, Champion older miler in Ireland in 1987, **won** 5 races and £47,911 including Gladness Stakes, Curragh, **Gr. 3**, Brownstown Matron Stakes, Curragh, **Gr. 3** and Fasig-Tipton Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.**, placed 6 times including third in Prix Perth, Saint-Cloud, **Gr. 3**, Ballysheehan Fairy King Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.** and fourth in Trusthouse Forte Mile, Sandown Park, **Gr. 2**, Mount Coote Stud Matron Stakes, Curragh, **Gr. 3** and Supreme Stakes, Goodwood, **Gr. 3**;
