RUN TO JANE (IRE), ran a few times at 2 and 3 years and ran once over hurdles at 3 years; dam of **six winners** from 9 runners and 10 living foals of racing age viz-

**BUDAPEST (IRE)** (2005 c. by Montjeu (IRE)), won 8 races at 3 to 7 years in Czech Republic and in Italy and £123,133, under both rules including Premio UNIRE Steeplechase, Treviso (twice).

**Beyond (IRE)** (2007 g. by Galileo (IRE)), won 6 races at 3, 4 and 6 years, 2013 and £28,479, under both rules, placed second in Gran Corsa Siepi di Pisa Hurdle, Pisa.

**TARO TYWOD (IRE)** (2009 f. by Footstepsinthesand (GB)), won 3 races at 2 to 4 years, 2013 and £11,224 and placed 7 times.
