ROSE DES ANDES (IRE) (1996 f. by Royal Academy (USA)), won 1 race at 3 years in France and £5188 and placed 4 times. Berenique (IRE) (2001 f. by Bering), in training. She also has a 2002 colt by Fasliyev (USA).
