LADY BANKES (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years and £5,470 viz Monkhill Limited Stakes, Pontefract, placed 4 times;

dam of two winners from 4 runners and 4 foals of racing age viz-

MOTEN SWING (GB) (1999 g. by Kris), won 3 races at 2 to 4 years, 2003 and £25,316 and placed 4 times.

DANZILI BAY (GB) (2002 c. by Dansili (GB)), won 1 race at 2 years, 2004 and placed once, from only 4 starts to date

The Thief (GB) (1998 g. by Robellino (USA)), placed once at 3 years, his only start before meeting with a fatal accident.
