Louve Bleue (USA), won 2 races at 3 and 4 years in France and in U.S.A. and placed 3 times including second in Prix Saint-Alary, Longchamp, Gr.1 and third in Yerba Buena Handicap, Golden Gate, L.; Own sister to LASCAUX (USA);

dam of four winners from 7 runners and 8 foals of racing age viz-

LOUVE MYSTERIEUSE (USA) (1996 f. by Seeking The Gold (USA)), won 3 races at 3 and 5 years in France and in U.S.A. and £82,752 including Prix Madame Jean Couturie, Vichy, L., placed 3 times.

Loup Bleu (USA) (1998 g. by Nureyev (USA)), won 1 race at 3 years in France and £9101 and placed 3 times; also placed once over hurdles and placed 6 times over jumps in France and £37,371 including second in Prix Finot Hurdle (c&g), Auteuil and third in Prix General de Saint-Didier Hurdle, Enghien-Soisy.

LOUVA (USA) (2001 f. by Atticus (USA)), won 1 race at 4 years, 2005 in France and £9755 and placed twice.

LUCKY WOLF (USA) (1999 c. by Atticus (USA)), won 1 race at 6 years, 2005 in France and £5917 and placed twice.

LOUP SOLITAIRE (USA), Champion 2yr old colt in France in 1995, won Grand Criterium, Longchamp, Gr.1 and second in Prix Lupin, Gr.1; sire.

LOUVE (USA), 2 races at 3 years in France and £56,404 including Prix de Flore, Saint-Cloud, Gr.3, placed 3 times; dam of LOUVE DES REVES (IRE), 2 races at 3 years, 2005 in France and £17,376.

Loudeac (USA), 2 races in France, £42,456, second in Prix de Fontainebleau, Longchamp, Gr.3 and third in Prix du Muguet, Saint-Cloud, Gr.2.
