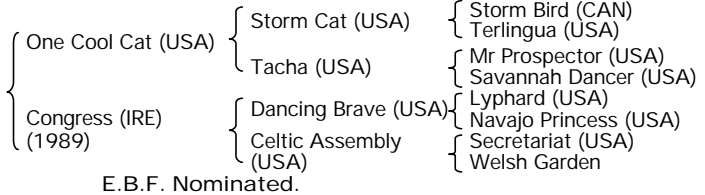

ROYAL INTRIGUE (IRE) (2003 c. by Royal Applause (GB)), won 3 races at 2 and 3 years, 2006 and £51,355 including Glenman Corporation Ltd. Lenebane Stakes, Roscommon, L., placed 3 times including third in Eyrefield Stakes, Leopardstown, L. and El Gran Senor Stakes, Tipperary, L., from only 7 starts.

UNITED NATIONS (GB) (2001 g. by Halling (USA)), won 2 races at 3 and 5 years, 2006 and £17,974 and placed 6 times.

SERRA NEGRA (GB) (1997 f. by Kris), 1 race at 3 years, £6,508, placed 3 times.

PROMESSA (GB) (1996 f. by Reprimand), 1 race at 3 years and placed 3 times.

Collow (GER) (g. by Lando (GER)), winner in Germany and in Switzerland, placed third in Prix Vulcain, Maisons-Laffitte, L.

CONANGA (GER), 7 races at 2 to 5 years in Italy, £51,904, placed 15 times.

CONTAT (GER), won 1 race at 3 years, 2006 in Germany and placed twice.
