ENCHANTING EVE (GB), won 5 races at 2 and 3 years and £16,589, placed 9 times; dam of two winners from 4 runners and 4 foals of racing age viz-
Red Romeo (GB) (2001 g. by Case Law), won 5 races at 2 to 4 years, 2005 and £43,669, placed 10 times including third in Be Hopeful Stakes, Newmarket, L.
ROSS GELLER (GB) (2000 g. by Case Law), won 4 races at 3, 5 and 6 years, 2006 in France and in Germany and £21,462 and placed 12 times.
Alisdanza (GB) (2002 f. by Namaqualand (USA)), placed 5 times at 4 years, 2006.
Bogside Katie (GB) (2004 f. by Hunting Lion (IRE)), placed once at 2 years, 2006.

RED SAILS, placed once over hurdles; dam of two winners from 3 runners and 4 foals of racing age including-
I AM SAILING (GB), won 7 races in Sweden and £15,277 and placed 13 times.

HELM, won 1 race at 3 years and placed once, from only 3 starts; dam of one winner from 4 runners and 9 foals of racing age viz-
HAWSER, won 1 race in Switzerland; also won 2 races over hurdles, placed 5 times including third in Aurelius Hurdle, Ascot, won 1 race over jumps in West Germany.

Boathouse, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and placed once viz third in Sun Chariot Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.2, from only 4 starts; dam of winners.
DRY DOCK, 2 races at 2 and 3 years including Chester Vase, Chester, Gr.3, placed 3 times including third in St Leger Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.1; sire.
River Patrol (GB), winner, second in Virginia Stakes, Newcastle, L.; dam of *NORSE DANCER* (IRE), Champion older horse in Ireland in 2004, 4 races at 2, 4 and 5 years, 2005 including Sovereign Stakes, Salisbury, Gr.3, placed 14 times including second in International Stakes, York, Gr.1.
Head of The River, placed once; dam of *GOOD FAITH* (NZ), Champion 2yr old filly in New Zealand in 1996-97, won Ford Dealer Team Sires' Produce Stakes, Ellerslie, Gr.1.
Charlotte Dundas (GB), placed once at 3 years; dam of *BAND GIPSY* (USA), won Grande Premio Presidente da Republica, Gavea, Gr.1.
