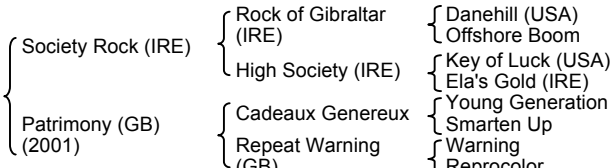

PATRIMONY (GB), unraced;

dam of **three winners** from 4 runners and 6 foals of racing age viz-

ROCKATELLA (IRE) (2007 f. by Rock of Gibraltar (IRE)), won 2 races at 3 and 4 years in Italy and £101,007 viz Premio Royal Mares, Milan, **L.** (twice), placed 5 times including second in Walther J Jacobs Stutenmeile, Bremen, **Gr.3**, EBF Festa Rennen, Cologne, **L.**, third in Prix de Lieurey, Deauville, **Gr.3** and Premio Sergio Cumani C. Naz, Milan, **Gr.3**.

PATRIMONIUM (IRE) (2009 f. by Green Desert (USA)), won 3 races at 3 and 4 years at home and in New Zealand and £21,250 and placed 5 times.

GIRL ON FIRE (IRE) (2011 f. by Desert Style (IRE)) won 2 races in Germany, placed 4 times.

Rock To The Moon (IRE) (2012 c. by Arcano (IRE)), ran in Germany at 3 years, 2015.

LEEBAZ (NZ), won Sky TB Central A D Hollindale Stakes, Gold Coast, **Gr.2** and second in Titan Energy Doomben Cup, Doomben, **Gr.1**.

POLISH KNIGHT (NZ), won Myer Tulloch Stakes, Rosehill, **Gr.2** and second in David Jones AJC Australian Derby, Randwick, **Gr.1**.

SUEZ (GB) (f. by Green Desert (USA)), won 2 races at 2 years and £71,237 including EBF Irish TB Marketing Dick Poole Stakes, Salisbury, **L.**, placed once viz second in Sky Bet Cheveley Park Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**, all her starts; dam of winners.

LYRIC OF LIGHT (GB), 3 races at 2 years and £136,946 including Shadwell Fillies' Mile Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**, from only 4 starts.

CEZANNE (GB), Champion older horse in Ireland in 1994, won 10 races at 3 to 5 years at home, in Germany and in U.A.E. including Irish Champion Stakes, Leopardstown, **Gr.1**.

COLORSPIN (FR), won 3 races at 2 and 3 years including Gilttown Stud Irish Oaks, Curragh, **Gr.1**, placed fourth in Gold Seal Oaks Stakes, Epsom, **Gr.1**; dam of winners.

KAYF TARA (GB), Champion older stayer in Europe in 1998, 1999 & 2000, 10 races at 3 to 6 years at home and in France including Ascot Gold Cup, **Gr.1** (twice); sire.

OPERA HOUSE (GB), Champion older horse in Europe in 1993, won Ever Ready Coronation Cup, Epsom, **Gr.1**, Coral Eclipse Stakes, Sandown Park, **Gr.1**; sire.

ZEE ZEE TOP (GB), 3 races at home and in France including Prix de l'Opera, Longchamp, **Gr.1**; dam of **IZZI TOP (GB)**, 6 races at home and in France including Pretty Polly Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.1**, **JAZZI TOP (GB)**, 3 races at 3 years, 2015 at home and in France including Prix de la Nonette, Deauville, **Gr.2**.

Spinning The Yarn (GB), ran once at 3 years; dam of **NECKLACE (GB)**, Champion 2yr old filly in Ireland in 2003, 2 races including Moyglare Stud Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.1**.

BELLA COLORA, won 4 races at 2 and 3 years at home and in France including Prix de l'Opera, Longchamp, **Gr.2**, third in 1000 Guineas, Newmarket, **Gr.1**; dam of winners.

STAGECRAFT, Champion older horse in Europe in 1991 (9.5-11 f.), won Prince of Wales's Stakes, Royal Ascot, **Gr.2**, Canadian Turf Handicap, **Gr.2**; sire.

RAPPA TAP TAP (FR), won 3 races at 2 and 3 years including Blue Seal Stakes, Ascot, **L.**; third dam of **ZAFISIO (IRE)**, won Criterium International, Saint-Cloud, **Gr.1**.
