*Overcall*, won 3 races at 3 years and £10,763 and placed twice including fourth in Royal Whip Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3; Own sister to *Overplay*;

dam of seven winners from 11 runners and 11 foals of racing age including-

*OVERBURY (IRE)* (c. by Caerleon (USA)), won 4 races at home, in Hong Kong and in U.S.A. and £483,060 including American Derby, Arlington Int., Gr.2 and The Queen Elizabeth II Cup, Sha Tin, L., second in Derby Italiano, Rome, Gr.1, Deutsches Derby, Hamburg, Gr.1, Earl of Sefton Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.3, Foundation Stakes, Goodwood, L., third in Royal Lodge Stks, Ascot, Gr.2; sire.

*Lammas (IRE)* (c. by Lammtarra (USA)), won 2 races at 3 years and £15,395 and placed 4 times including third in Ballysax Stakes, Leopardstown, L.; also placed twice at 5 years, 2002 in U.S.A. and £9603.

*Call My Guest (IRE)*, won 2 races and placed 5 times; also won 7 races over hurdles and placed 28 times including second in Martell Mersey Novices' Hurdle, Liverpool, third in Crowngap Winter Novices' Hurdle, Sandown Park.

*CRUZEIRO (GB)*, won 3 races at 3, 5 and 6 years, 2002 in France and in Hong Kong and £118,147 and placed 10 times.

*OVERRÜLED (IRE)*, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and placed once; dam of winners.

*VINTAGE TIPPLE (IRE)* (f. by Entrepreneur (GB)), 3 races at 2 and 3 years, 2003 and £175,033 including Darley Irish Oaks, Curragh, Gr.1, placed once viz second in EBF Athasi Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3, from only 5 starts.

*Spettro (IRE)* (c. by Spectrum (IRE)), 3 races; also 2 races at 4 years, 2002 in Italy and placed 5 times including third in Gran Criterium, Milan, Gr.1.

*NIGHTLARK (IRE)*, won 1 race and placed 7 times; dam of winners.

*NIGHTWATCHMAN (IRE)*, 2 races at 3 and 4 years, 2003 and placed 7 times.

*MUTAJJEB (IRE)*, 1 race at 3 years, 2003 and £5920 and placed once.

*Melodramatic*, won 3 races at 2 and 3 years and placed 4 times including second in Strensall Stakes, York, L. and third in Coronation Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.2;

dam of ten winners from 13 runners and 16 foals of racing age including-

*OVERACT (IRE)* (f. by Law Society (USA)), won 3 races at home and in Belgium and £19,181 including Prix Gutt - Tattersalls, Ostend, L.; dam of a winner.

*Overplay* (f. by Bustino), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £13,485 and placed 7 times viz second in Athasi Stks, Curragh, Gr.3, third in Ribblesdale Stks, Royal Ascot, Gr.2, fourth in Irish 1000 Guineas, Curragh, Gr.1; dam of winners.

*VINTAGE CROP*, Champion older stayer in Europe and Australia in 1994, Champion older horse in Ireland in 1993, won Jefferson Smurfit Mem. Irish St Leger, Curragh, Gr.1 (twice), Foster's Melbourne Cup, Flemington, Gr.1, second in Ascot Gold Cup, Royal Ascot, Gr.1 and third in Foster's Melbourne Cup, Flemington, Gr.1; also winner over jumps.

*FIFTH QUARTER*, winner in France; dam of *Yulara (IRE)*, 2 races and placed twice; also placed once in France viz third in Prix du Pin, Longchamp, L.

*Overstay*, unraced; grandam of *VINTHEA (IRE)*, 3 races at 2 and 3 years, 2002 including McDonogh EBF Handicap, Galway, L., placed twice.

*CROWN WITNESS*, won 6 races at 3 and 4 years, placed 4 times; dam of winners.

*TRIOAN CROWN (IRE)*, 2 races including Fay Richwhite Solera Stakes, Newmarket, L., placed second in Child Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.2.
