COLONEL COLLINS (USA), won Washington Singer Stakes, Newbury, L., second in Craven Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.3, Somerville Tattersall Stakes, Newmarket, L., third in Ever Ready Derby Stakes, Epsom, Gr.1, Budweiser Irish Derby, Curragh, Gr.1 and 2000 Guineas, Newmarket, Gr.1; sire.
