COLORVISTA, unraced;

dam of five winners from 5 runners and 11 foals of racing age viz-

Mudeer (GB) (c. by Warning), won 2 races and placed 3 times including second in Racing Post Trophy Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.1; also placed once in France.

Christian Name (GB) (f. by Cadeaux Genereux), won 1 race in Japan and £96,092 and placed once viz third in Hakodate Sansai Stakes, Hakodate, L.

STEP FORWARD (GB), won 7 races at 3, 5 and 6 years in Japan and placed twice.

AMIR ZAMAN (GB), won 5 races at 3, 5 and 6 years, 2004 and placed 9 times; also placed twice over hurdles.

DURABLE (GB), won 2 races at 3 years and £12,074 and placed 3 times.

ZEE ZEE TOP (GB), 3 races at home and in France including Prix de l'Opera Casino Barriere Enghien, Longchamp, Gr.1.

Spinning The Yarn (GB), ran once; dam of NECKLACE (GB), Champion 2yr old filly in Ireland in 2003, 2 races viz Moyglare Stud Stakes, Curragh, Gr.1, third in Beverly D Stakes, Arlington International, Gr.1.

CEZANNE (GB), Champion older horse in Ireland in 1994, won 10 races at home, in Germany and in U.A.E. including Champion Stakes, Leopardstown, Gr.1 and Spreiti-Rennen, Baden-Baden, Gr.3; also won 1 race over hurdles; sire.

BELLA COLORA, won 4 races at home and in France including Prix de l'Opera, Longchamp, Gr.2, third in 1000 Guineas, Newmarket, Gr.1; dam of winners.

STAGECRAFT, Champion older horse in Europe in 1991 (9.5-11 f.), won Prince of Wales's Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.2, second in Eclipse Stakes, Sandown, Gr.1, third in Juddmonte International Stks, York, Gr.1; sire.

HYABELLA (GB), 3 races including Ben Marshall Stakes, Newmarket, L.; grandam of FRANCE (GB), 2 races including Tetrarch Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3, second in Entenmann's Irish 2000 Guineas, Curragh, Gr.1.

BALALAIKA (GB), won Dahlia Stakes, L.; dam of ALKAADHEM (GB), 3 races at 3 and 4 years, 2004 including Festival Stakes, L.

RAPPA TAP TAP (FR), won 3 races including Blue Seal Stakes, Ascot, L., placed 5 times including fourth in Child Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.3; dam of winners.
