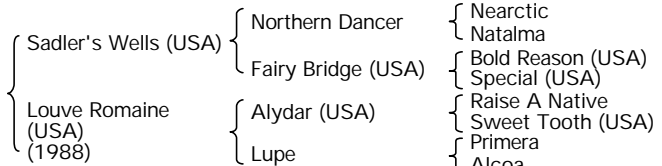

dam of five winners from 5 runners and 6 foals of racing age viz-

- LOUP ROMAIN* (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years in France, £16,539 and placed 4 times.

- LOUVETERIE (USA) (f. by Nureyev (USA)), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years in France including Prix Vanteaux, Longchamp, Gr.3, second in Prix de Diane, Chantilly, Gr.1 and Prix Saint-Alary, Longchamp, Gr.1; dam of winners.
- LOUP SAUVAGE (USA), Champion older horse in Europe in 1998 (9.5-10.5f.), won Prix d'Ispahan, Longchamp, Gr.1, second in Dubai Champion Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.1, Poule d'Essai des Poulains, Longchamp, Gr.1, third in Irish Derby, Curragh, Gr.1 and Dubai World Cup, Gr.1; sire.
- LOUP SOLITAIRE (USA), Champion 2yr old colt in France in 1995, won Grand Criterium, Longchamp, Gr.1 and second in Prix Lupin, Gr.1; sire.
- LOUVE (USA), won 2 races at 3 years in France and £56,404 including Prix de Flore, Saint-Cloud, Gr.3, placed 3 times.
- Loudeac (USA), 2 races in France, £42,456, second in Prix de Fontainebleau, Longchamp, Gr.3 and third in Prix du Muguet, Saint-Cloud, Gr.2.
- Louveteau (USA), 1 race at 3 years in France and £19,142 and placed 3 times including third in P.Eugene Adam (G.P. de Maisons-Laffitte), Gr.2.
- L'ILE DU REVE (USA) (f. by Bold Lad (USA)), won 2 races, £13,297 including Cheshire Oaks, Gr.3, placed once, from only 4 starts; dam of winners.
- L'ILE MYSTERIEUSE (USA), winner in France and in U.S.A.; dam of PREMIER COLLECTION (IND), won Idar Gold Trophy, Pune, L., Ocean of Angels (IND), winner in India, second in S A Poonawalla Million, Pune, L.
- Louve Bleue (USA) (f. by Irish River (FR)), won 2 races in France and in U.S.A., placed second in Prix Saint-Alary, Longchamp, Gr.1; dam of winners.
- LOUVE MYSTERIEUSE (USA), won Prix Madame Jean Couturie, Vichy, L. Louveciennes (USA), placed 3 times; grandam of SMUGGLER'S SONG (IRE), 3 races including Airlie Stud Silver Stakes, Curragh, L.; also 1 race over hurdles.
