Retired to Stud in 2005, first crop now yearlings.

KINGSCLERE (GB) (1997 g. by Fairy King (USA)), won 7 races at home and in France and £90,582 including Sovereign Bookmakers Easter Stakes, Kempton Park, L., placed second in Stardom Stakes, Goodwood, L., third in Royal Lodge Stakes, Ascot, Gr.2 and Solorio Stakes, Sandown Park, Gr.3.
