WEEKEND SURPRISE (USA), won Golden Rod Stakes, Churchill Downs, Gr.3, second in La Canada Stakes, Santa Anita, Gr.1; dam of SUMMER SQUALL (USA), won Preakness Stakes, Pimlico, Gr.1; sire, A P INDY (USA), Champion 3yr old colt in U.S.A. in 1992, won Belmont Stakes, Belmont, Gr.1, Breeders' Cup Classic, Gulfstream, Gr.1; champion sire.
