GOVERNOR BROWN (USA), Chesnut horse, 2000, by Kingmambo (USA), out of Miss Mistletoes (IRE), by The Minstrel (CAN). Won 3 races, value £94,996, at 2 to 4, from 7 furlongs to 1 mile 1½ furlongs, Somerville Tattersall Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.3, also placed third in Criterium International, Saint-Cloud, Gr.1. Retired to Stud in 2006, and sire of the winners of 3 races, and £14,079; including *DANGER MULALLY (GB)* (Sadler's Wells (USA)), *SAMSAM (IRE)* (Chilibang).
