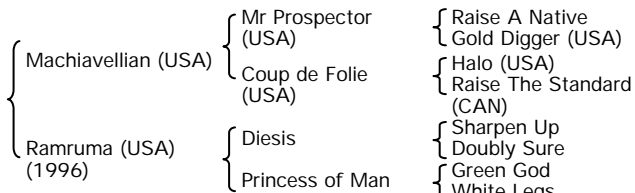

RAMRUMA (USA), Champion 3yr old filly in Europe in 1999, won 5 races at 3 years and £530,470 including Kildangan Stud Irish Oaks, Curragh, Gr.1, Vodafone Oaks Stakes, Epsom, Gr.1, Aston Upthorpe Yorkshire Oaks, York, Gr.1 and Oaks Trial Stakes, Lingfield Park, L., placed 5 times including second in St Leger Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.1, third in Yorkshire Oaks, York, Gr.1 and Riggs Bank Harvest Stakes, Ascot, L., from only 11 starts; Own sister to ROYAL SCIMITAR (USA) and AUSHERRA (USA);

dam of one winner from 3 runners and 6 foals of racing age viz-

Flying Cross (IRE) (c. by Sadler's Wells (USA)), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years, 2010 and £40,383 and placed twice including third in Irish St Leger, Curragh, Gr.1.
