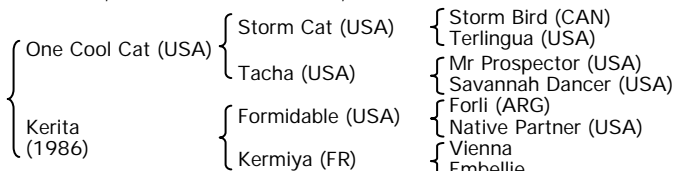

KERAKA (USA) (f. by Storm Bird (CAN)), won 2 races at 2 years and £28,030 including EBF Anglesey Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3, placed 4 times; dam of 4 winners.

KERMIYANA (IRE) (f. by Green Desert (USA)), won 2 races at 3 years including Brownstown Stakes, Leopardstown, L.; dam of Kerdem (IRE) (c. by Rainbow Quest (USA)), 6 races to 2009 at home and in Australia and £81,834, second in Adelaide Cup, Morphettville, Gr.2 (twice); grandam of KARASIYRA (IRE) (f. by Alhaarth (IRE)), 2 races at 2 and 3 years, 2010 and £54,210 including Lenebane Stakes, Roscommon, L., second in Noblesse Stakes, Cork, Gr.3.
