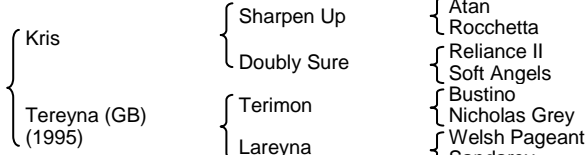

dam of **ten winners** from 16 runners and 17 foals of racing age including-

Grecian Bridge, won 1 race at 3 years, second in Blue Seal Stakes, Ascot; dam of winners.

ROY BRIDGE, won Cecil Frail Handicap, Haydock Park, **L.**; sire.

SEALAND (FR), won 3 races at 3 years in France and placed once; dam of winners.
