SUAVE SHOT (GB), ran once at 3 years;

dam of 2 foals of racing age viz a 2002 gelding by Kayf Tara (GB) and a 2003 filly by Polish Precedent (USA).

2nd Dam

Optaria, won 1 race at 2 years and placed 3 times including third in Precocious National Stakes, Sandown Park, L.;

dam of six winners from 8 runners and 8 foals of racing age viz-

GREY SHOT (GB) (g. by Sharrood (USA)), won 6 races at home and in France and £175,000 including Garrard Goodwood Cup, Goodwood, Gr.2, Portland Place Props. Jockey Club Cup, Newmarket, Gr.3, Prix de Lutece, Longchamp, Gr.3 and Bahrain Trophy, Newmarket, L., placed second in Prix Vicomtesse Vigier, Longchamp, Gr.2, Prix Kergorlay, Deauville, Gr.2, Insulpak Sagaro Stakes, Ascot, Gr.3 and third in Chester Rated Handicap, Chester, L.; also won 5 races over hurdles and £84,644 including Axminster 100 Kingwell Hurdle, Wincanton, Murphy's Draughtflow Handicap Hurdle, Cheltenham and Tanglefoot Elite Limited Handicap Hurdle, Wincanton, placed twice viz second in Sun'King of the Punters' Tolworth Hurdle, Sandown Park and Bonusprint Bula Hurdle, Cheltenham and won 2 races over fences and £13,379.
