Ankara (USA), won 7 races at home and in Australia, placed second in Royal Whip Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.3**, third in Australian Cup, Flemington, **Gr.1**, Robert A Lee Stakes, Morphettville, **L.** and fourth in Alister Clark Stakes, Moonee Valley, **Gr.2**; sire.
Indian Lore (USA), won 8 races at home and in U.S.A., placed second in Midsummer Scurry Handicap, Curragh, **L.**; sire.
 Siparia (USA), placed 5 times in France; grandam of **NERAKS EMAN (USA)**, won Fonner Park Special Handicap (c&g), Fonner Park.
