**ELNADIM (USA)**, Champion older sprinter in Europe in 1998, won Darley July Cup, Newmarket, **Gr.1**; sire.

**MEHTHAAF (USA)**, Champion 3yr old filly in England in 1994, won Airlie Coolmore Irish 1000 Guineas, Curragh, **Gr.1**.

**ONLY SEULE (USA)**, winner in France; dam of **OCCUPANDISTE (IRE)**, Champion older mare in France in 1997, 6 races in France including Prix de la Foret, Longchamp, **Gr.1**; grandam of **IMPRESSIONNANTE (GB)**, 3 races at 2 and 3 years in France including Prix de Sandringham, Chantilly, **Gr.2**, placed second in Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, Longchamp, **Gr.1**.

**BIANCONI (USA)** (c. by Danzig (USA)), won 3 races at 3 years and £80,303 including Racad Diadem Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.2**, placed 4 times; sire.

**COLORADO DANCER** (f. by Shareef Dancer (USA)), won 3 races at 3 years in France, £112,296 including Prix de Pomone, Deauville, **Gr.2**; dam of winners.
