INTREPIDITY (GB), Champion 3yr old filly in Europe in 1993, **won** 5 races at 2 and 3 years at home and in France and £512,333 including Oaks Stakes, Epsom, **Gr.1**, Prix Saint-Alary, Longchamp, **Gr.1**, Prix Vermeille Escada, Longchamp, **Gr.1** and Prix Finlande, Longchamp, **L.**, placed second in Prix Ganay, Longchamp, **Gr.1** and Prix Foy, Longchamp, **Gr.3**;

dam of **five winners** from 8 runners and 11 foals of racing age viz-
DEODATUS (USA) (1998 c. by Darshaan), won 10 races at 3 to 7 years in U.A.E. and £152,535 and placed 14 times.

BARONIAL (GB) (2002 c. by King's Best (USA)), won 2 races at 4 and 6 years in Czech Republic and placed 4 times.

WILD GEESE (IRE) (2007 g. by Cape Cross (IRE)), placed 4 times at 3 and 4 years; also won 1 race over hurdles and placed 3 times and placed once over fences.

BATTLE READY (IRE) (2003 g. by Mark of Esteem (IRE)), won 1 race at 3 years in Japan and £14,142 and placed 6 times.

WESTPHALIA (USA) (2000 f. by Gone West (USA)), won 1 race at 2 years in France and placed once; dam of a winner.

Mughamerr (GB) (1996 f. by Mr Prospector (USA)), placed 3 times at 3 years in France; dam of 3 winners.

Mughal (JPN), ran in Japan at 3 years; dam of **No Stir (JPN)**, winner to 2012 in Japan, third in Metropolitan Stakes, Tokyo, **L.**

Our Hope (GB), unraced; dam of **Derivative (IRE)**, 2 races at 2 years, placed second in Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial Stakes, Leopardstown, **L.**; also 3 races over hurdles, **Harrington (IRE)**, 1 race, placed third in Navigation Stakes, Cork, **L.**

Wydah (GB), unraced; dam of **Hobby (GB)**, 1 race at 2 years and £32,430 and placed 6 times including third in Ribblesdale Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.2**.

ACUSHLA (f. by Storm Bird (CAN)), Champion older sprinter in Ireland in 1987, won 4 races at 3 and 4 years and £80,570 including Phoenix Sprint, Phoenix Park, **Gr.3** (twice) and Flying Five, Phoenix Park, **L.**, third in Park Stakes, Phoenix Park, **Gr.3**; dam of a winner.

Tribeca (GB), placed 3 times at 3 years; dam of **Tritonia (GR)**, 1 race at 3 years in France, second in Prix Joubert, Maisons-Laffitte, **L.**, Prix Panacee, Toulouse, **L.**

SQUADRON LEADER (USA) (c. by Storm Bird (CAN)), won 2 races at 2 years in U.S.A. and £33,113 including Jim Bowie Stakes, Dueling Grounds, **L.**; sire.

RIVER PRINCE (USA) (c. by Forli (ARG)), won 1 race at 3 years viz Herbertstown Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.**, placed third in Stackallen Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.**; sire.
