HYABELLA (GB), won 3 races at 3 years inc. Ben Marshall Stakes, Newmarket, L. and Atalanta Stakes, Sandown Park, L.; grandam of FRANCE (GB), won 2 races inc. EBF Tetrarch Stakes, Gr.3, second in Irish 2000 Guineas, Gr.1, third in Goffs International Stakes, Gr.2.

BALALAIKA (GB), won 2 races including Dahlia Stakes, Newmarket, L.

KAYF TARA (GB), Champion older stayer in Europe in 1998, 1999 & 2000, won 10 races including Ascot Gold Cup, Royal Ascot, Gr.1 (twice) and Jefferson Smurfit Memorial Irish St Leger, Curragh, Gr.1 (twice); sire.

OPERA HOUSE (GB), Champion older horse in Europe in 1993, won Coronation Cup, Epsom, Gr.1, Coral Eclipse Stakes, Sandown Park, Gr.1, King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes, Ascot, Gr.1; sire.

ZEE ZEE TOP (GB), won Middleton Stakes, York, L., third in Pretty Polly Stakes, Curragh, Gr.2 and Vodafone Nassau Stakes, Goodwood, Gr.1.

Highland Dress (GB), winner, second in Brigadier Gerard Stakes, Sandown Park, Gr.3 and third in Hardwicke Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.2.
