

dam of two winners from 5 runners and 5 living foals of racing age-

GOLD CLIPPER (GB) (1994 c. by High Kicker (USA)), won 1 race at 4 years and £4,155 and placed 4 times; also placed twice over hurdles.

FRECKLES (GB) (1995 f. by High Kicker (USA)), won 1 race, £3,185 at 3 years; also placed twice over hurdles and won 1 race over jumps in Belgium.

Gold Kicker (GB) (1993 c. by High Kicker (USA)), placed once at 2 years, died at 3 years.

PRAIRIE (c. by Posse (USA)), won 8 races at 3 to 7 years in France, in Italy and in Sweden, £48,364 including Premio Alessandro Sambruna, Milan, L., placed second in SARA Open Sprint - Veckans Komb, Taby, L. and third in Taby Open Championship, Taby, L. (twice); sire.

Trojan Miss (f. by Troy), won 1 race at 2 years and £8,909, placed third in Sheraton Park Tower Lupe Stakes, Goodwood, **L.**; dam of winners.

True Bearing (USA), placed second in Prix Lovelace, Evry, **L.**, Prix de Saint Patrick, Longchamp, **L.** and Grand Prix du Conseil General de Seine et Marne, Fontainebleau, **L.** and third in Prix de Tourgeville, Deauville, **L.**

ROUSETTE (IRE), placed once at 2 years; also won 2 races at 5 and 7 years in France, £2,954.

MOUNTAIN BLOOM (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years and £3,860; also won 1 race and £2,786 over hurdles and won 2 steeplechases and £10,856.

DRY GINGER (IRE), won 1 race at 4 years in Holland, £1,107.

ROSY HUE (IRE), won 1 race at 3 years and £6,220.

EMPHATIC (IRE), won 3 races and £13,386 over hurdles.
