*PARAGON OF VIRTUE (GB)*, **won** 1 race (10f.) at 5 years viz The Littlewoods Bet Direct Maiden Stakes, Lingfield Park, 2002 and £11,481 and placed 5 times.

#### **1st Dam**

**MADAME DUBOIS**, **won** 5 races and £113,306 at home and in France including Park Hill Stakes, Doncaster, **Gr.2** and Prix de Royallieu, Longchamp, **Gr.2**, placed twice including second in Galtres Stks, York, **L.** and Ballymacoll Stud Stks, Newbury, **L.**; dam of **five winners** from 6 runners and 8 foals of racing age-

**COUNT DUBOIS (GB)** (1998 c. by Zafonic (USA)), Champion 2yr old colt in Italy in 2000, **won** 2 races and £111,637 at home and in Italy including Gran Criterium, Milan, **Gr.1**, placed 4 times including third in Tom McGee Autumn Stakes, Ascot, **L.**

**Place de L'Opera (GB)** (1993 f. by Sadler's Wells (USA)), **won** 2 races at 3 years and £11,628, placed twice including third in Food Brokers Aphrodite Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**, from only 5 starts; dam of a winner.

**HIGH PITCHED (GB)** (c. by Indian Ridge), 5 races at 3 and 4 years, 2002 including Levy Board St Simon Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3** and Grundon Aston Park Stakes, Newbury, **L.** and placed twice.

*RICHELIEU (IRE)* (1992 g. by Kris), **won** 1 race at 3 years and £5,132 and placed once; also placed once over hurdles.

*GALETTE (GB)* (1996 f. by Caerleon (USA)), **won** 1 race at 3 years and £5,959 and placed once, all her starts.

*Nuance (IRE)* (1995 f. by Rainbow Quest (USA)), placed once at 3 years.

**Sun And Shade (GB)** (f. by Ajdal (USA)), **won** 1 race; also **won** 3 races in U.S.A., placed second in Lady Morvich Handicap, Bay Meadows, **L.**; dam of winners.

**DAGGERS DRAWN (USA)**, 3 races including Laurent-Perrier Rose Champagne Stakes, Doncaster, **Gr.2** and Salomon Brothers Richmond Stakes, Goodwood, **Gr.2**; sire.

#### **3rd Dam**

**MILLY MOSS**, **won** 1 race at 3 years viz Cheshire Oaks, Chester, **Gr.3**, placed once fourth in Oaks Stakes, Epsom, **Gr.1**, from only 4 starts;

dam of **nine winners** from 10 runners and 10 foals of racing age including-

**MILL ON THE FLOSS**, **won** 2 races at 2 and 3 years including Oaks Trial Stakes, Lingfield Park, **L.**, placed second in Ribblesdale Stakes, **Gr.2**; dam of winners.

**BOSHAM MILL (GB)**, **won** Prix Scaramouche, M'-Laffitte, **L.**, placed third in Great North East. Railway Doncaster Cup, Doncaster, **Gr.3**.

**Kashmir Lass**, **won** 4 races at 2 and 3 years, placed second in Sun Chariot Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.2**; dam of winners.
