Tribeca (GB), placed 3 times at 3 years; dam of **Tritonia (GR)**, placed second in Prix Joubert, M^l-Laffitte, **L.**

RIVER PRINCE (USA), won 1 race at 3 years viz Herbertstown Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.**, placed third in Stackallen Stakes, Phoenix Park, **L.**; sire.

SQUADRON LEADER (USA), won 2 races in U.S.A. including Jim Bowie Stakes, Dueling Grounds, **L.**; sire in U.S.A.
