GRAND LODGE (USA) (c. by Chief's Crown (USA)), Champion 2yr old in Europe in 1993, won 4 races at 2 and 3 years and £429,513 including Dewhurst Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**, St James's Palace Stakes, Royal Ascot, **Gr.1** and Somerville Tattersall Stakes, Newmarket, **L**, placed 8 times including second in Dubai Champion Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.1**, 2000 Guineas, **Gr.1** and third in Champion Stakes, Leopardstown, **Gr.1**, Sussex Stakes, Goodwood, **Gr.1**; sire.

dam of **seven winners** from 7 runners and 11 foals of racing age viz-

LOST CHORD, won 5 races at home and in South Africa including Turffontein Handicap, Turffontein, **L**, placed second in Gallinule Stakes, Curragh, **Gr.2**, Transvaal Champion Stakes, Turffontein, **Gr.3** and third in White Rose Stakes, Ascot, **Gr.3**; sire in South Africa.
