LADY SHIPLEY (f. by Shirley Heights), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £51,755 including Lupe Stakes, Goodwood, L., placed 3 times viz second in Vodafone Nassau Stakes, Goodwood, Gr.2, third in Princess Royal Stakes, Ascot, Gr.3 and fourth in Yorkshire Oaks, York, Gr.1; dam of winners.
