GLORIOUS (GB), unraced; Own sister to Oriane (GB); dam of three winners from 9 runners and 6 foals of racing age viz- *WONDROUS* (GB) (2002 c. by Danzero (AUS)), won 3 races at 3 and 4 years, 2006 in Greece and £20,080.

ATHBOY (GB) (2001 g. by Entrepreneur (GB)), won 2 races at 3 years and £6811.
ABUNDANT (GB) (2000 f. by Zafonic (USA)), won 1 race at 2 years and £6849 and placed twice, all her starts.

COLORSPIN (FR), won 3 races at 2 and 3 years including Irish Oaks, Curragh, Gr.1 and Rochford Thompson Newbury Stakes, Newbury, L.; dam of winners.

KAYF TARA (GB), Champion older stayer in Europe in 1998, 1999 & 2000, won Ascot Gold Cup, Gr.1 (twice) and Irish St Leger, Gr.1 (twice); sire.

OPERA HOUSE (GB), Champion older horse in Europe in 1993, won Eclipse Stakes, Gr.1, King George VI & Queen Elizabeth Stakes, Ascot, Gr.1; sire.

ZEE ZEE TOP (GB), won Prix de l'Opera, Longchamp, Gr.1.

Spinning The Yarn (GB), ran once; dam of *NECKLACE* (GB), Champion 2yr old filly in Ireland in 2003, won Moyglare Stud Stakes, Curragh, Gr.1.

BELLA COLORA, won 4 races at home and in France including Prix de l'Opera, Gr.2, Waterford Candelabra Stakes, Goodwood, Gr.3; dam of winners.

STAGECRAFT, Champion older horse in Europe in 1991 (9.5-11 f.), won Prince of Wales's Stakes, Ascot, Gr.2, Canadian Turf Handicap, Gr.2; sire.

MULLINS BAY (GB), won Strensall Stakes, York, Gr.3.

HYABELLA (GB), won Ben Marshall Stakes, Newmarket, L.; grandam of *FRANCE* (GB), won EBF Tetrarch Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3.
