**EAGLE EYED (USA)** (c. by Danzig (USA)), won 4 races at 2 and 3 years in France and in U.S.A. and £239,798 including Arlington Classic, Gr.2, Sausalito Handicap, Golden Gate, L. and Pirate Cove Handicap, Santa Anita, L., second in Prix d'Arenberg, Longchamp, Gr.3 and Baldwin Stakes, Santa Anita, L.; sire.
