ZENDA (GB), won 3 races at home, in France and in U.S.A. including Gainsborough Poule d'Essai des Pouliches, Longchamp, Gr.1, placed second in Coronation Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.1 and Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup Stakes, Keeneland, Gr.1.
