HOH MAGIC (GB) (1992 f. by Cadeaux Genereux), Champion 2yr old filly in Europe in 1994, won 4 races and £170,272 at home and in France including Prix Morny, Deauville, Gr.1, Molecomb Stakes, Goodwood, Gr.3 and Sino Group Dragon Trophy, Sandown Park, L., placed 7 times including second in Gainsborough Stud Fred Darling Stakes, Newbury, Gr.3 and third in July Cup, Newmarket, Gr.1 and Queen Mary Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.3.

GUNMASTER (1986 c. by Precocious), won 1 race at 2 years and £3,794 and placed twice; also won 5 races at 3, 4 and 6 years in Hong Kong, £81,008.

HANDSOME SINGER (GB) (1993 c. by Cadeaux Genereux), won 9 races in U.A.E., £33,572.

GUNNER'S DAUGHTER (GB) (1989 f. by Pharly (FR)), won 1 race at 3 years and £1,742 and placed once.
