

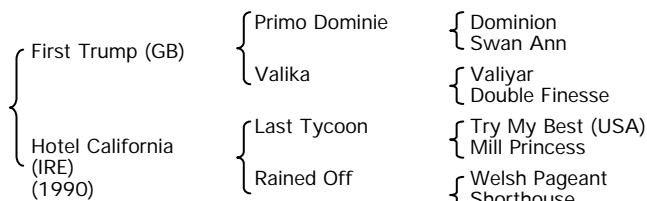

GOLDIE (GB) (1998 f. by Celtic Swing (GB)), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years, 2001 and £17,131 and placed 3 times.

Ruff (GB) (1996 f. by First Trump (GB)), placed once at 3 years and placed twice at 4 years, 2000 in France.
