

dam of **one winner** from 3 runners and 3 foals of racing age- **Mail The Desert (IRE)** (2000 f. by Desert Prince (IRE)), won 1 race at 2 years, 2002, £14,572, placed twice including third in Milcars Star Stakes, Sandown Park, L.; also placed once in France, £2,515, all her starts.

Dockside (IRE) (1997 f. by Brief Truce (USA)), placed once at 2 years.

Boathouse, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £11,403, placed once third in Sun Chariot Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.2, from only 4 starts;

dam of four winners from 10 runners and 12 foals of racing age viz-DRY DOCK (c. by High Line), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £59,987 including Dalham Chester Vase, Chester, Gr.3, placed second in Great Voltigeur Stakes, York, Gr.2 and third in Holsten Pils St Leger Stakes, Doncaster, Gr.1; sire.
