dam of two winners from 3 runners and 3 foals of racing age viz-

RECHARGE (IRE) (2006 c. by Cape Cross (IRE)), won 2 races at 2 and 3 years, 2009 and £93,350 including Leopardstown 2000 Guineas Trial, Leopardstown, Gr.3, placed twice, from only 5 starts.
