PIPALONG (IRE) (1996 f. by Pips Pride (GB)), Champion older mare in Europe in 2001, won 10 races and £421,698 including Stanley Leisure Sprint Cup, Haydock Park, Gr.1, Duke of York Stakes, York, Gr.3, Palace House Stakes, Newmarket, Gr.3, placed second in Cherry Hinton Stk, Newmarket, Gr.2, Duke of York Stakes, York, Gr.3, Queen Mary Stakes, Royal Ascot, Gr.3, third in Darley July Cup, Newmarket, Gr.1, Nunthorpe Stakes, York, Gr.1 and Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp, Longchamp, Gr.1 (twice); dam of a winner viz- WALK ON BYE (IRE) (f. by Danehill Dancer (IRE)), won 2 races at 2 years, 2009 and £75,137 including Anglesey Stakes, Curragh, Gr.3, placed third in Phoenix Stakes, Curragh, Gr.1, all her starts to date.

RAJA (IRE) (2005 f. by Pivotal (GB)), won 2 races at 2 years and £15,307; also won 2 races at 3 years, 2008 in France and £28,420 and placed twice.

HENRY KITCHENER (IRE) (1993 c. by Common Grounds), won 2 races at 3 years in U.S.A. and £16,544 and placed 6 times.

NUFOUDH (IRE) (2004 g. by Key of Luck (USA)), won 1 race at 5 years, 2009 and £5,466 and placed 9 times.
