*STROKE OF SIX (IRE)*, won 2 races at 2 and 3 years and £15,730 including Niodini Handicap, Haydock Park, placed 9 times; Own sister to Flip Flop And Fly (IRE); dam of three winners from 3 runners and 3 living foals of racing age viz-  
*MISS PHOEBE (IRE)* (2005 f. by Catcher In The Rye (IRE)), won 5 races at 2 and 4 years, 2009 and £18,376, under both rules and placed 7 times.  
*SOHCAHTOA (IRE)* (2006 g. by Val Royal (FR)), won 2 races at 2 years and £50,216 and placed 6 times.  
*MARCUS CICERO (IRE)* (2007 g. by Le Vie Dei Colori (GB)), won 2 races at 2 years, 2009 and £12,972 and placed twice.
