KRISTAL BRIDGE (GB), placed once at 3 years;

dam of six winners from 6 runners and 7 foals of racing age viz-

- ARBELLA (GB) (2002 f. by Primo Dominie), won 2 races at 4 years and £38,731 including EBF Joan Westbrook Pinnacle Stakes, Haydock Park, L., placed 6 times including third in Blue Square Ormonde Stakes, Chester, Gr.3, from only 9 starts. OVERTURN (IRE) (2004 g. by Barathea (IRE)), won 8 races at 2 to 7 years, 2011 and
- £419,564, under both rules including Chester Cup, Chester, Northumberland Plate, Guinness Galway Handicap Hurdle, Galway and Samsung Scottish Champion Hcp Hurdle, Ayr, placed 12 times including second in Swinton Handicap Hurdle, Haydock Park and Christmas Hurdle, Kempton Park.
- **FISHER BRIDGE (IRE)** (2003 g. by Singspiel (IRE)), won 8 races at 4 to 7 years, 2010 and £159,633, under both rules including ladbrokes.com Handicap Hurdle, Fairyhouse, placed 11 times including second in For Auction Novice Hurdle, Navan, Kilbegnet EBF Novice Chase, Roscommon, Munster National Hcp Chase, Limerick.
- ROTATIVE (GB) (2005 f. by Spinning World (USA)), won 4 races at 3 and 4 years and £20,571 and placed twice, from only 7 starts.
- PALAMEDES (GB) (1999 g. by Sadler's Wells (USA)), won 2 races at 4 and 6 years and £13,589 and placed 3 times.

 - TYRONE BRIDGE, 5 races at 3, 4 and 6 years including EBF Curragh Cup, Curragh, L. and Foster's Silver Cup Stakes, York, L., placed second in Ascot Gold Cup, Royal Ascot, Gr.1 and Irish St Leger, Curragh, Gr.1; also 4 races over hurdles including Crowngap Winter Novices' Hurdle, Sandown Park, Reynoldstown Cup Novices' Hurdle, Wolverhampton and 1 race over fences.
