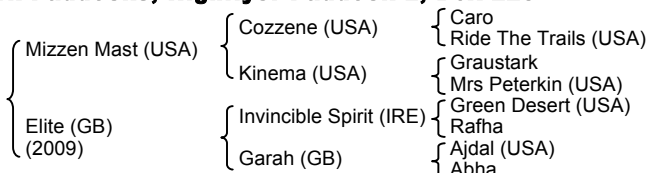

*DIFFERENT VIEWS (USA)* (2014 g. by Proud Citizen (USA)), won 1 race at 3 years, 2017 in France and placed twice.

**Garah (GB)**, won 4 races at 3 and 4 years and £41,988 and placed 9 times including second in Duke of York Stakes, York, **Gr.3**, Rous Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**, Hopeful Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**, third in United Breweries Group Temple Stakes, Sandown Park, **Gr.2** and Remembrance Day Stakes, Doncaster, **L.** (twice);

dam of **six winners** from 8 runners and 11 foals of racing age including-

**OLDEN TIMES (GB)** (c. by Darshaan), won 3 races at 3 and 5 years at home and in France and £221,982 viz Prix Jean Prat, Chantilly, **Gr.1**, Weatherbys Earl of Sefton Stakes, Newmarket, **Gr.3** and Feilden Stakes, Newmarket, **L.**, placed 9 times including third in Juddmonte Lockinge Stakes, Newbury, **Gr.1** (twice) and St James's Palace Stakes, Royal Ascot, **Gr.1**; sire.

**SABRE DANCE**, won Land Of Burns Stakes, Ayr, **L.**, second in Prince of Wales's Stakes, Royal Ascot, **Gr.2**, third in Transvaal Champion Stakes, Turffontein, **Gr.2**; sire.

**VALKYRIE**, 1 race at 2 years; dam of **VALENTINE**, won Premio Le Marmore, Rome, **L.** and third in Premio Guido Beradelli, Rome, **Gr.2**; grandam of **HARRISON**

**GEORGE (IRE)**, 10 races including Guisborough Stakes, Redcar, **L.**

*DAME DE FER*, won 1 race at 3 years and placed 6 times; dam of winners.

**Devious (SAF)**, winner in South Africa, second in Ashburton Training Centre Handicap, Scottsville, **Gr.3** and third in Administrator's Stakes, Scottsville, **Gr.2**; dam of **PRIVATE RESERVE (SAF)**, Champion 2yr old in South Africa in 1998-99, won Allan Robertson Fillies Championship, Scottsville, **Gr.1** and Mondl South African Nursery Plate, Turffontein, **Gr.1**.
